IN MEMORIAM

SGM SALVATORE ORLANDO



It is with deep sadness to announce the passing of Sal Orlando, who passed away at the age of 96 on August 14, 2023. Sal had the distinction of being the oldest, and only WWII veteran, in attendance at our annual reunions for the past several years. Sal was drafted into the Army in WWII and later served with the 169th Infantry Regiment in Bad Tolz, Germany during the Korean War. After a long and distinguished career, Sal continued to serve veterans in retirement for over twenty years as a member of the Honor Guard providing funeral service for deceased service members. He was very active in several veterans' association including The Veterans of Foreign Wars, Korean War Veterans Association and 169th Infantry Veterans Corp. In addition to his military associations, Sal was also a Mason, Shriner and a devoted Boy Scouts Leader.

ROBERT (BOB) STORY: Bob passed away on May 4, 2022 at the age of 93. He serviced with the 169th Infantry Regiment in Germany during the Korean War.

LADISLAUS (TED) SACHARKO:



Ted was 94 when he passed away on April 30, 2022. He began his 38 year military career by joining the Marine Corps immediately following graduation from High School. Upon his release from the Marine Corps, he enlisted in the Connecticut Army National Guard. Ted was accepted into the first CTARNG Officer Candidate School and graduated as a 2nd Lieutenant. In 1950 he was mobilized for the Korean War and served in the 169th Infantry Regiment in Germany as part of the Army

of Occupation forces. Ted became a full time National Guard Technician shorty after is return from Germany and retired from technical service after 20 years and a total military service of 38 years with the rank of Sergeant Major. Ted's service to the military continued

after retirement in several veteran's organizations in New Britain. He served as the Commander of the 169th Infantry Regiment Corps, the New Britain Council of Veterans and served as Commissioner of Veteran's Affairs for the City of New Britain.
